

## Removal Guide

### STEP 1: Prep

- Sanitize your customer's hands and your own.

### STEP 2: Top coat removal

- Remove the top coat using a 120/180 grit file, filing the surface of the leftover gel until the shine completely removed.

### STEP 3: Soak off

- Soak wipes in 100% acetone, wrap in foil or place (folded) in nail clips. Leave to soak for 10 to 15 minutes, this may vary depending on the products used e.g. glitters, number of layers, nail art

### STEP 4: Removal

- Unwrap the first nail whilst keeping the others wrapped in gel remover.
- Use a cuticle pusher to gently remove the gel.
- The gel should remove easily. If it is difficult to remove, allow the gel to soak for longer.
- Use a sharp cuticle pusher

### STEP 5: Buff & shape

- If there is residue left, use a 100/180 grit buffer to gently buff it off.
- Avoid over buffing the natural nail, concentrating on areas around the cuticles.
- Once all the product is removed, apply cuticle oil
